Technologies in the Arts</p>	<p>How do you care for a musical instrument?</p> <p>What are the proper steps to caring for your instrument?</p> <p>Students will be able to demonstrate proper care and maintenance of his/her instrument by doing the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Loosening and tightening the bow before and after practice</li> <li>• Cleaning the instrument and bow stick to remove excess rosin after practice</li> <li>• Keeping the instrument in the case when not in use</li> <li>• Keeping the instrument away from extreme changes of temperature</li> <li>• Carrying the instrument carefully at all times.</li> <li>• Using the fine tuners to adjust the pitch of the strings</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Set routine when taking out/preparing instrument and bow for use</li> <li>• Set routine for putting away instrument and bow</li> <li>• Teacher demonstration and mimic by students</li> <li>• Fine tuner adjustment exercises</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teacher observation.</li> <li>• Periodic checks of condition of instruments by teacher</li> <li>• Oral quizzes on care and maintenance of the instrument</li> <li>• Instrumental report cards</li> <li>• Teacher evaluation of condition of bow and need for rosin</li> <li>• Report card will go home indication student's progress on care and maintenance</li> </ul>
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
