**1. Mandated Reporter Training [1Be] (8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.)**

Presenter: Sara Ullmer, Supervisor of Community Programs, Crime Victims Council of the Lehigh Valley

Location: High School Cafeteria

**Description:** This presentation reviews the elements of child abuse, including the legal definitions of a child, perpetrator, and categories and indicators of abuse. The training provides an overview of mandated reporting obligations, including how to make a report, protections for those who report, and the liability for failing to report. Mandated Reporter is required as a 5 year rolling renewal requirement.

**2. Mandated Reporter Training Part 2: Educator Discipline Act [1Be] (12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.)**

Facilitator: Lydia Hanner, Director of Curriculum and Instruction

Location: High School Cafeteria

**Description:** All teachers must complete Part 2 of Mandated Reporter, which is the Educator Discipline Act & Sexual Misconduct. It is an additional regulation that the state of PA has mandated. This training will be a large group instruction in the high school cafeteria. Mandated Reporter 2 is required as a 5 year rolling renewal requirement.
