

Instrument Repair

Even with taking good care of an instrument, repairs may be needed at times. Though your child's instrumental teacher has the ability to fix some minor problems, most should be dealt with by a licensed instrument repairperson.

For instrument being rented from Montero Violins:

You have the option of taking your child's instrument directly to Montero Violins as soon as you notice a repair is needed. You may also have your child bring the instrument to his or her next lesson and the instructor will take care of sending the instrument to Montero Violins for repairs. Basic repairs are covered under your rental agreement. Damage and destruction are not covered. You will need to pay for those repairs. A loaner instrument will be given to your child as soon as possible after it is brought in to school. If a loaner is not immediately available at the time of your repair, you may request one from Montero Violins. Broken strings are not covered. You may contact Montero Violins to authorize billing and to have them bring a replacement string to your child's school

For instruments being rented from other stores:

Most stores will pick-up instruments from your child's school. Contact your rental store directly for more information.

For instrument owned by the student:

Stores that offer good repair services are Montero Violins in Emmaus and Nazareth Music Center in Nazareth. Your music teacher can replace broken strings for the cost of a new string.

Do not attempt to repair a musical instrument at home.

If a child breaks a string, please have the student bring the instrument to us early in the morning and we will replace the string. There is so little time during the lesson that we don't want to use that valuable time repairing instruments.
